- 4) Email your abstracts to moms.ogsm@gmail.com before 1st March 2020.
- 5) There will only be one mode of presentation which is a physical poster.
- 6) Once the abstract submission has been successful, a confirmation email will be sent to you. Please ensure your email address is correct.
- 7) Selected presenting authors will be notified before 7th March 2020.
- 8) Once accepted, the Registration Fee for the presenting author should be paid by 15th March 2020.
