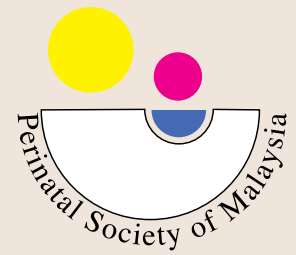

Introduction

In an experiential learning environment, debriefing serve the role of 'making sense' of the experience the learners went through. It is a form of feedback to the learners but utilities guided reflection approach led by a facilitator or debriefer. In an educational simulation activity, debriefing form the integral part of teaching and learning. However, not all educators, teachers or trainers are well verse with the debriefing technique. They usually more comfortable of giving a direct feedback compared to performed debriefing to the learners. In this course we will share with the participants on how to performed debriefing using a technique call DeBRIEF.

Course Objective:

At the end of the course the participants should be able to:

1. describe the usefulness, indication and reason of performing debriefing
2. identify the important elements in debriefing
3. describe the DeBRIEF technique of debriefing
4. perform a simulated debriefing using the DeBRIEF technique
