President Asian Society of Fertility Preservation (ASFP)



Nao Suzuki MD, PhD is a Professor and Chairman of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at St. Marianna University School of Medicine, Kanagawa, Japan since 2011. He completed his medical training at the School of Medicine, Keio University (Tokyo, Japan) in 1990, and obtained his PhD in Obstetrics and Gynecology, Graduate School of Medicine, Keio University in 2000. His specialty are Gynecologic Oncology, Palliative Medicine and Reproductive Medicine (fertility preservation for the CAYA cancer patients). Dr. Nao Suzuki established a non-profit organization Japan Society for Fertility Preservation (JSFP) on November 2012 and is now the president of JSFP. He is a board member of International Society for Fertility Preservation (ISFP). In 2016, Dr. Nao Suzuki established the Asian Society for Fertility Preservation (ASFP) including 14 countries in Asia. His recent clinical research activities cover a wide range of cancer therapies against gynecologic cancer, with particular focus on clinical trials, ovarian cancer research and development of targeted drugs. He also focused on the research aiming at the improvement of the field of Oncofertility research in Japan, and he performed ovarian tissue vitrification for the CAYA cancer patients. The primary goal of Dr. Nao Suzuki's Oncofertility research is to establish more optimal and safer freezing techniques of ovarian tissue for using this technique in fertility preservation of young female cancer patients.
