Submission open: 8 December 2024- 15 March 2025 Date of announcement of abstracts acceptance: 1st April 2025

Prizes will be awarded to the top three best e-poster presentations.

Abstract submission can be done on ENDORSE 2025 official website at https://endorse.com.my/

Guidelines:

- The research must be the original work of the author(s).
- The first name listed on the abstract must be the submitting author. There is no limit on the number of submissions per author.
- Original research and case reports related to endometriosis and women's health are welcome.
- The abstract must not have been presented or published elsewhere.
- Abstracts must be written in clear English, typed in Microsoft Word, using Times New Roman font size 12, and limited to no more than 350 words.
- Abstracts must be structured as follows:
- For **research articles**: Aim, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusion, and Clinical Significance.
- For case reports: Introduction, Case Presentation, Discussion, and Conclusion.
- Accepted abstracts and the format for e-posters will be communicated to the authors.
- Participants must register for the conference before submitting an abstract.
- Once accepted, presenting authors must register for the conference.
